Volunteer Code of Conduct

(The document defines the District's expectations for school volunteers)

As a volunteer, I agree to abide by the following code of conduct:

- 1. Immediately upon arrival, I will report to the preschool instructor, and they will direct me on the check in process.
- 2. I will wear or show volunteer identification whenever required by the school to do so.
- 3. I will use only adult bathroom facilities (minors are excluded).
- 4. I agree never to be alone with individual students who are not under the supervision of teachers or school authorities.
- 5. I will not contact students outside of school hours without permission from the students' parents/guardians.
- 6. I agree not to exchange telephone numbers, home addresses, e-mail addresses or any other home directory information with students for any purpose unless it is required as part of my role as a volunteer. I will exchange home directory information only with parental and administrative approval.
- 7. I will maintain confidentiality outside of school and will share with teachers and/or school administrators any concerns that I may have related to student welfare and/or safety.
- 8. I agree not to transport students.
- 9. I will not disclose, use, or disseminate student photographs or personal information about students, self or others.
- 10. I agree only to do what is in the best personal and educational interest of every student.
- 11. I will keep my cell phone and other electronic device turned off while I am in the classroom.
- 12. As supervision is not available, I will not bring other children or non-students on campus while volunteering.

I agree to adhere to the "Volunteer Code of Conduct" at all times or cease volunteering immediately.

Under **Penal Code 290.95** any volunteer is required to disclose to school officials if he/she is a registered sex offender and that he/she has not been convicted of a sex, drug related or violent crime offense, and that there are no such criminal charges pending against him/her. Failure to disclose this fact may result in arrest, prosecution, and likely fine and imprisonment. I have read and understand the above.
